# Communicating with teenagers

#### Turn off the TV

The average family home in Australia has three TVs, three mobile phones, two computers, two dvd players and a video-game console. So how much time is your family using passive activities? "Make an effort to create

quality time together," Dr Sarah Edelman, clinical psychologist and author of Change Your Thinking (ABC Books) says. "That way your family can share in much richer, interpersonal experiences, which make your family unit feel bonded, secure and happy."

She suggests sharing meals at the dinner table and actually talking about school, activities, plans and friends; getting outdoors for a game of backyard cricket instead of flopping in front of the TV after work; having a regular family card or games night; or choosing a family dvd once a week that actually provokes discussion. **BY Michael Grose, Parenting expert - http://www.parentingideas.com.au/**
